Achensee Golf and Country Club

Achensee can offer golfers two courses on which to play the perfect round of golf. The 18-hole golf course in Pertisau at the foot of the Karwendel Mountains is one of the most beautiful courses in the entire Alpine region. The Achensee Golf and Country Club, established in 1934, is the oldest golf club in Tyrol. This course is a true golfing gem, with stately terrain and a wonderful location right on the largest lake in the Tyrol region. The Achensee Golf and Country Club is quite special in every respect: the 1st tee is practically in the middle of the village, and the other holes offer a pure alpine golf sensation. The clubhouse is the perfect location for rounding off the day after a successful game of golf, and it is an impressive building with modern yet homely architecture. The "19th hole" has a very special charm and a cosy atmosphere, due largely to the high-quality construction materials and wooden features. It is a very popular spot at all times, not least after the guest golf tournament which takes place every Thursday.

European Seniors Golf Championship 2011 in Pertisau

Pertisau will be completely devoting itself to golf from 9 to 11 June: the Achensee Golf and Country Club is the location for the European Senior Golf Championship. The 150 best senior golfers in Europe (ladies over 50, gentlemen over 55) are expected in Achensee.

Driving range and golf simulators

The driving range in Pertisau, which is playable from both sides, is perfect for warming up and practising your strokes. Alongside the two chipping greens and a putting green, there is also an extensive range of covered tees. The wonderful views of the shimmering Lake Achensee simply serve to add extra value to this top training ground. Two professional golfers are the perfect people to talk to when it comes to improving technique and getting more enjoyment from the "perfect swing".

Hotel Wiesenhof in Pertisau and Hotel Pfandler both also have brand new golf simulators, allowing players to train even when the weather is bad. The golf simulator analyses a player's shots and provides tips for making improvements in an attempt to perfect his or her game.

Posthotel Alpengolf

The second 9-hole golf course in this region, which belongs to the Posthotel, is located in Achenkirch on a beautiful high plateau directly adjacent to the Karwendel nature reserve.

This course is suitable for beginners and expert golfers alike, with its different tees and varied layout.

The Posthotel alpine golf facility offers everything a true golf fanatic requires. Golfers can also savour the cuisine in the charming "Dollnhof" clubhouse, a listed building that is more than 300 years old. The weekly guest tournaments are a good opportunity to take advantage of the impeccable range of services, while the "Posthotel Rallye" tournament takes place on Fridays.

Golfers can perfect their game in a pleasant setting in Achenkirch by making use of the new driving range, the putting and chipping greens, the pitching area and bunker training facility. And with a pro by your side, you can quickly begin to edge a little closer to your desired handicap.
